Lane writes in his essay Giving Voice to Place: Three Models for Understanding American Sacred Space , that, "sacred places are, first of all, 'storied' places - elaborately woven together on a cultural loom that joins every detail of the landscape within a community of memory" (73).

Densmore (1974) describes the story of "a hunting incident in which a party of men placed sweet grass on the fire when the camp was in danger of starving and they were going again to hunt. Medicine men kept sweet grass in the bag with their medicinal roots and herbs".

Bloomfield's field research in the Plains Cree language began in 1925 on the Sweet Grass and Star Blanket reserves, and produced two volumes of texts, each recorded in the original words of the elders. The better known of the two collections is Sacred Stories of the Sweet Grass Cree, which was recently reprinted in facsimile by Fifth House.

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### Sacred Stories of Sweet Grass Cree: Bloomfield, Leonard ...

Sweetgrass, also known as Holy Grass, Buffalo Grass, Vanilla Grass, and Zebrovka, is one of the four sacred plants, (including cedar, sage and tobacco) and is used as a tool for prayer and purification. Native people believe it is the hair of Mother Earth and is considered a gift from the Creator.
